Monica is visiting Tina in Tokyo. The weather is not very good so they decide to stay home and watch TV.

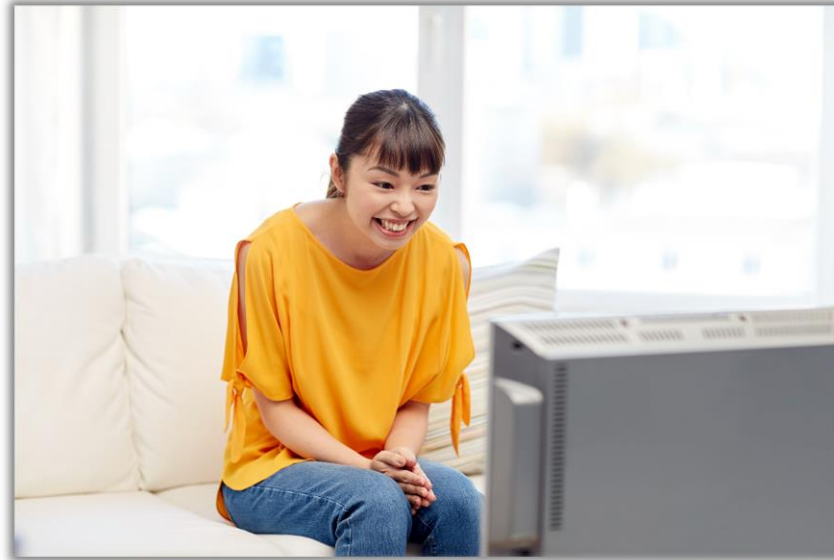

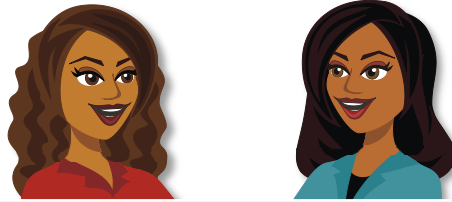
