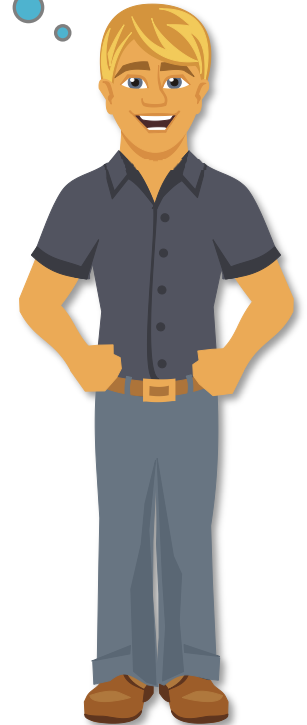


Tina	Oh my gosh, Scott! What are you wearing?
