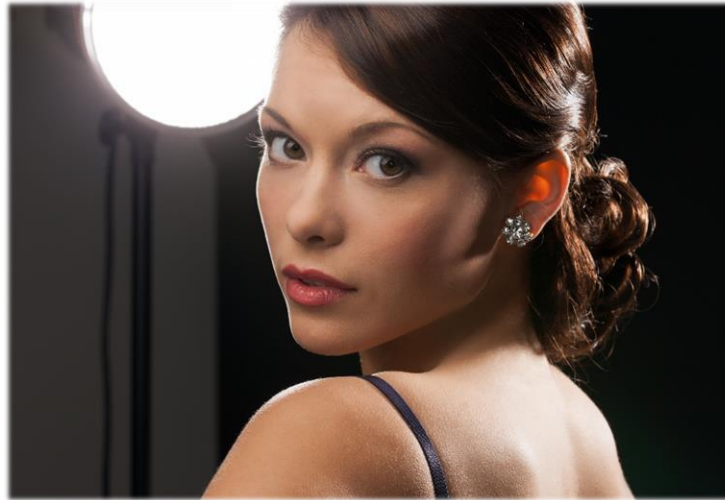

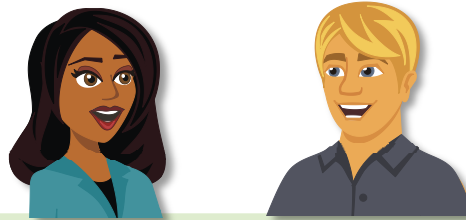


Who is the man getting out of the car?
